



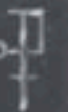

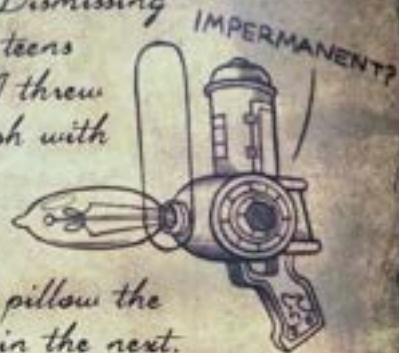
WE'LL MEET AGAIN...

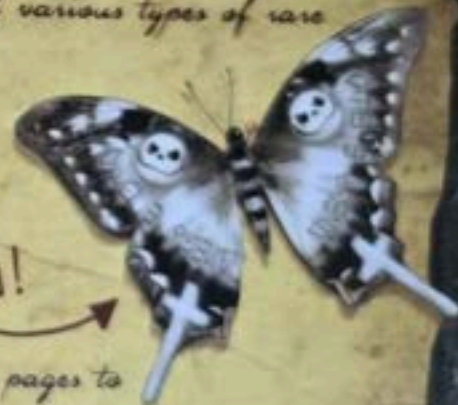
If you're the type to ignore reason even when it's staring you in the face, then I'm sure the last thing you want is to be scolded by some old man, wagging one of his six fingers at you.

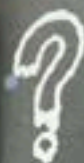
Almost every dream is about her mom. Sorry, Pine Tree!

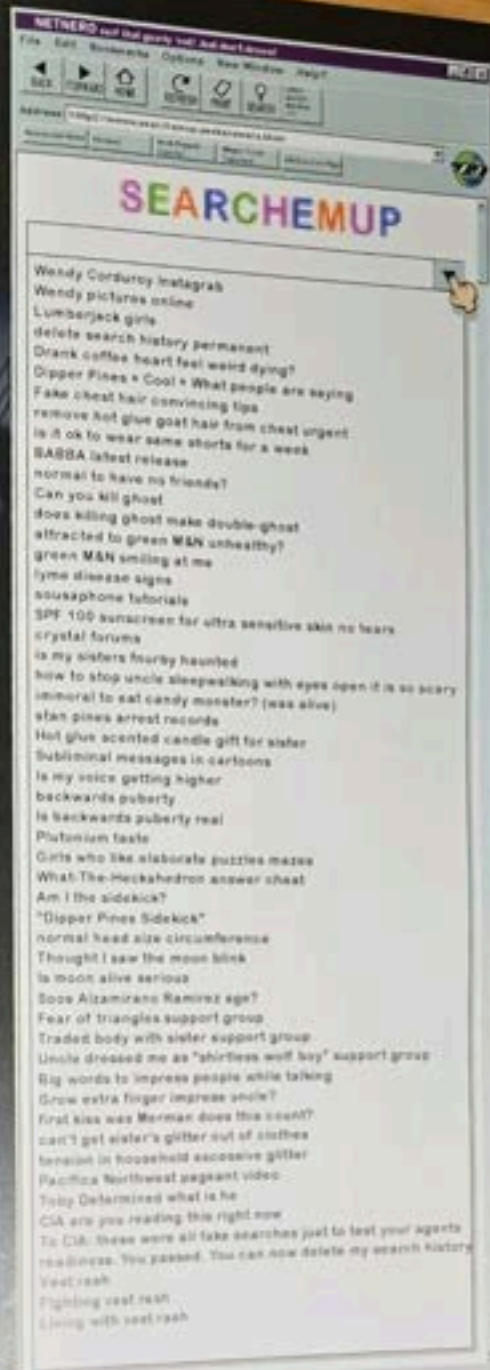
-Forgot to clear his search history on Soos's browser, and Mabel saw ALL this.

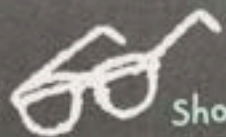

Umm... rude?? Finally, he hit me with

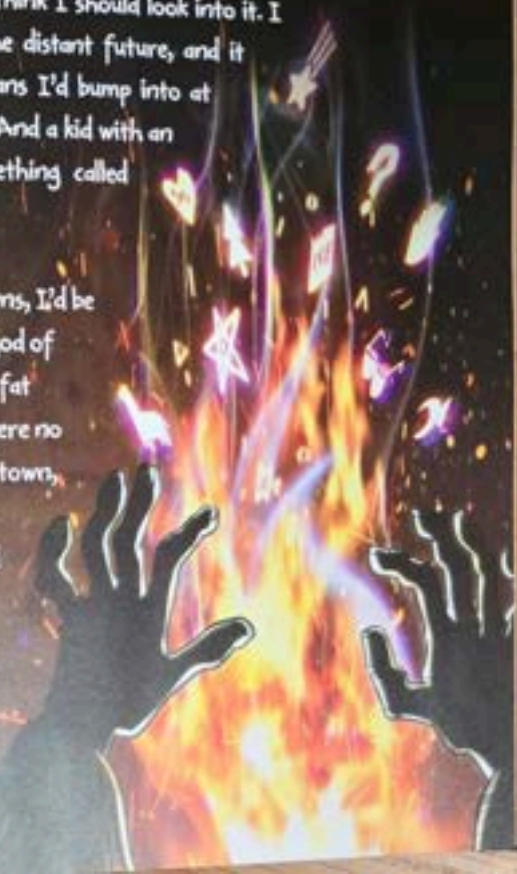
THE PROPHECY

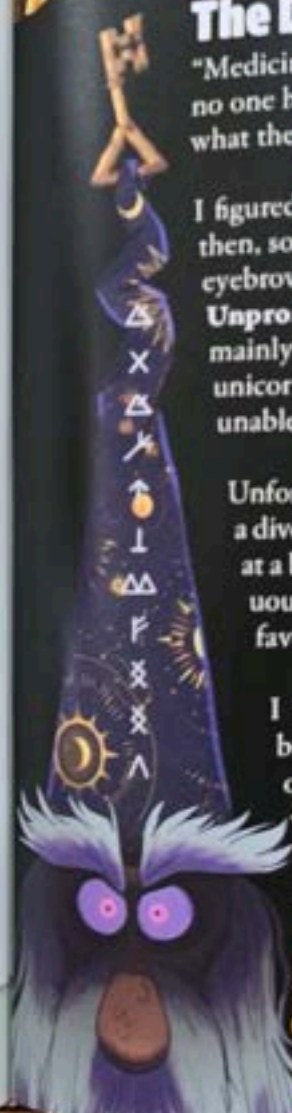
DON'T QUIT YOUR DAY JOB, ARCHBALD!

Snowed In

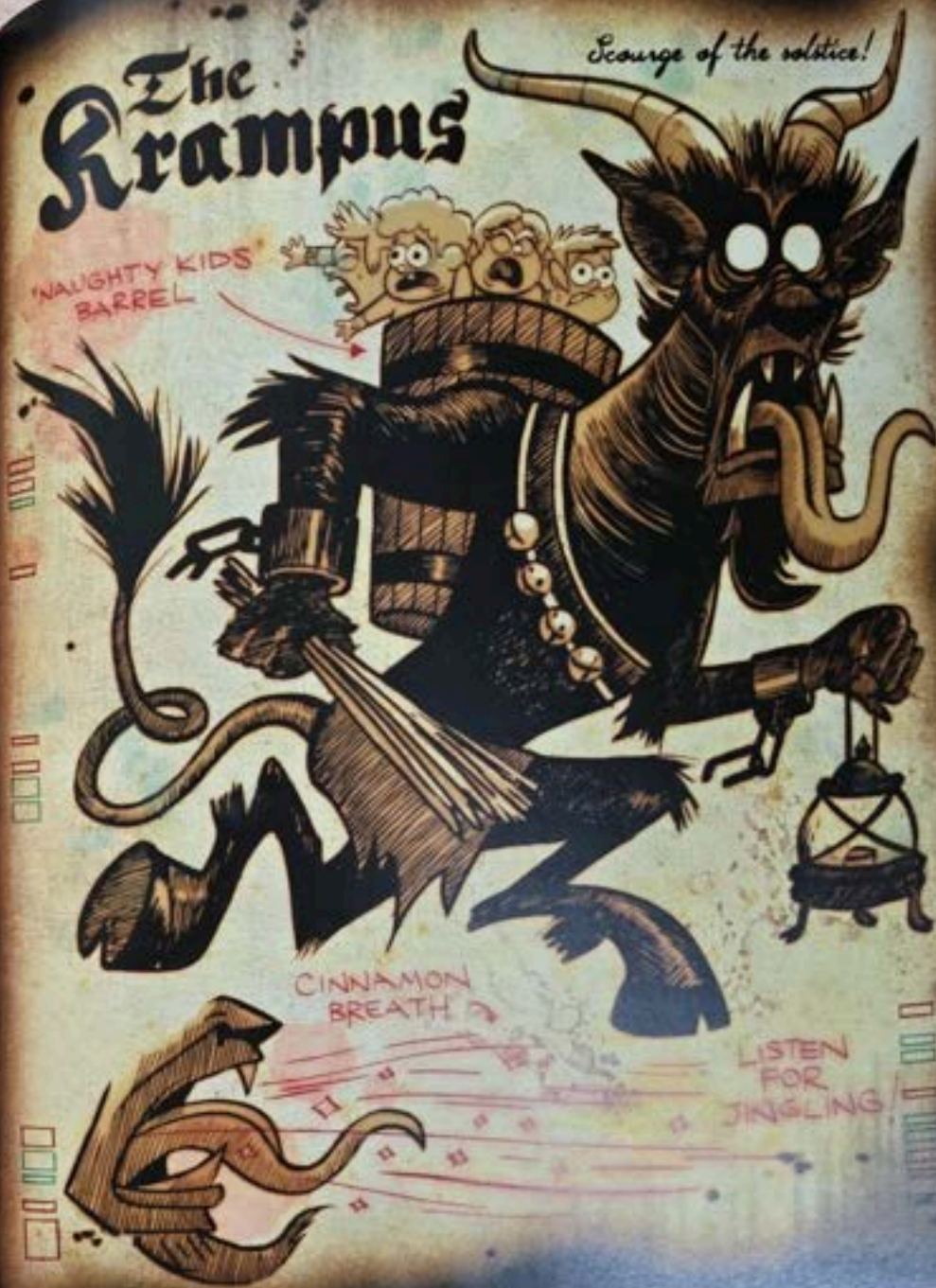

Dream, or Warning?

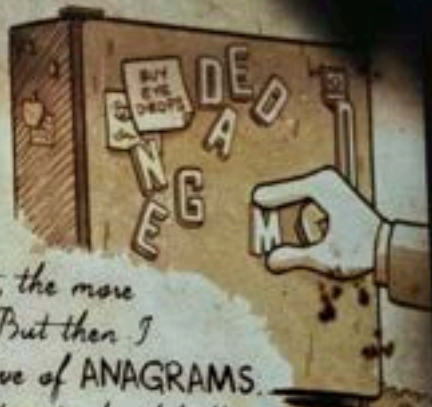

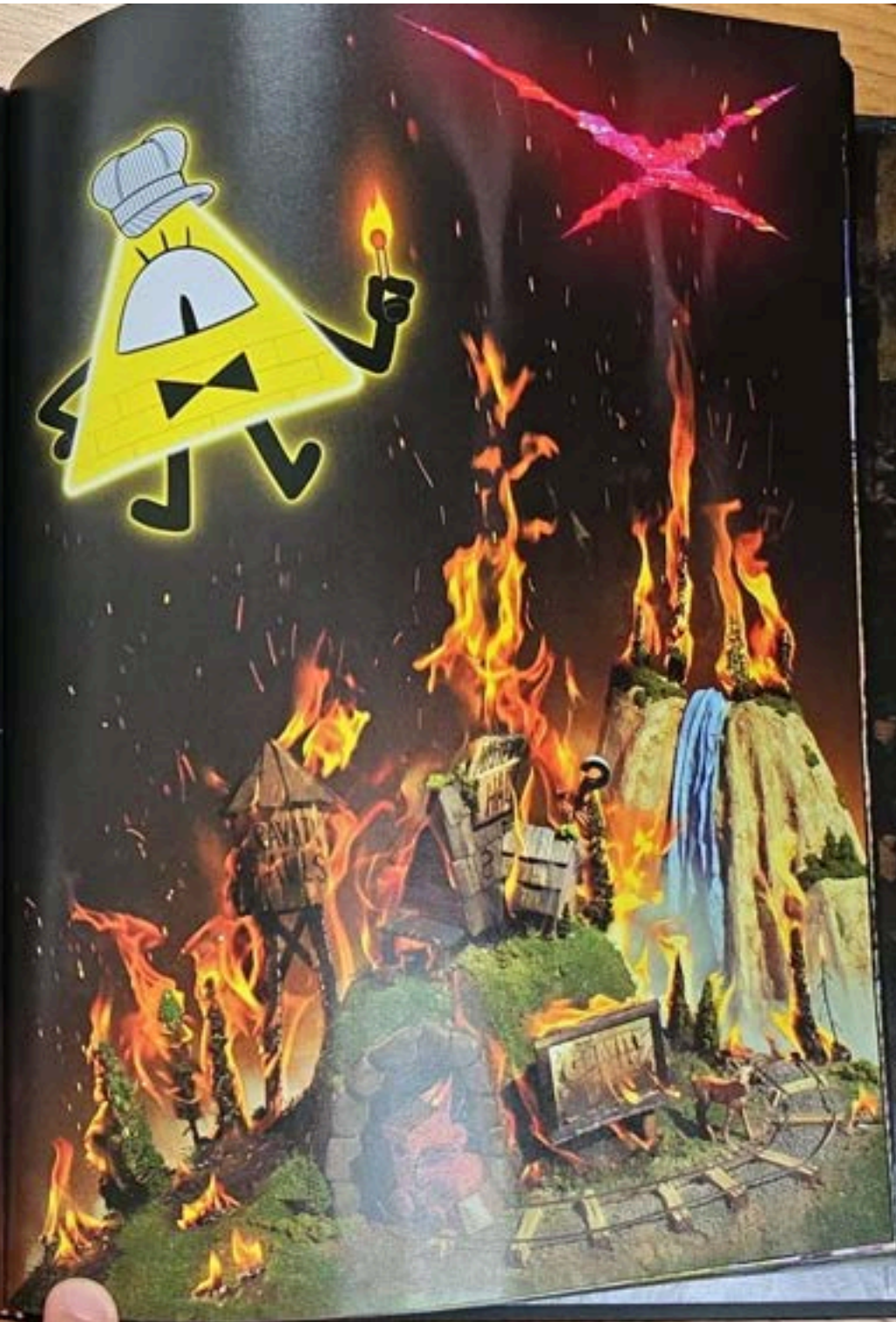
WEIRD MAGEDDON

THE PLAN

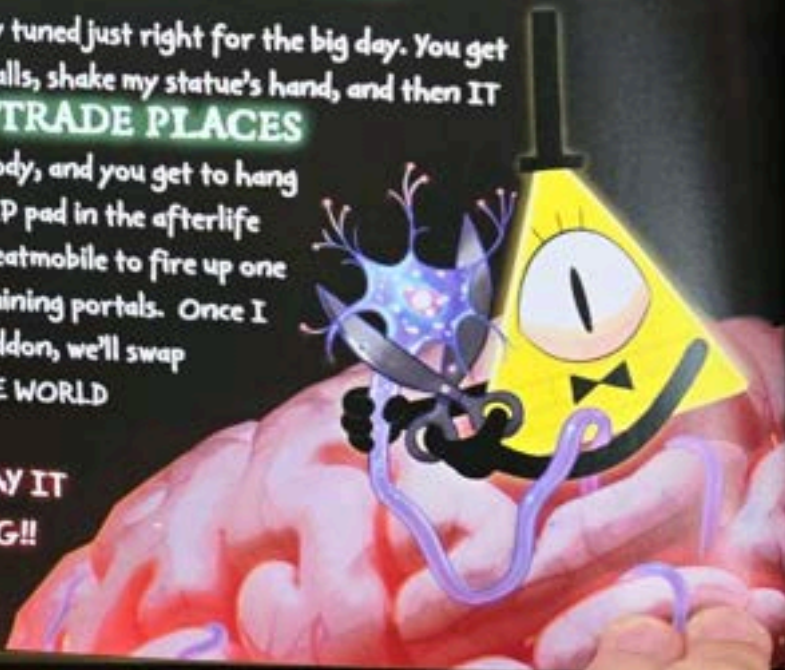
